

Print this form onto a piece of brown paper. Cut the card along the solid lines. Then apply glue to the entire back of the card. Place a piece of white muslin on the glued form, then place the beige inner page of the form (with glue on it too) on top of the form. Make sure you've aligned the edges. Then place this under a press to dry. When dry, score the vertical folds from the inside. (I used the edge of a spoon to score it) Then trim at the crop marks.
