### Private Sentenced to Death!

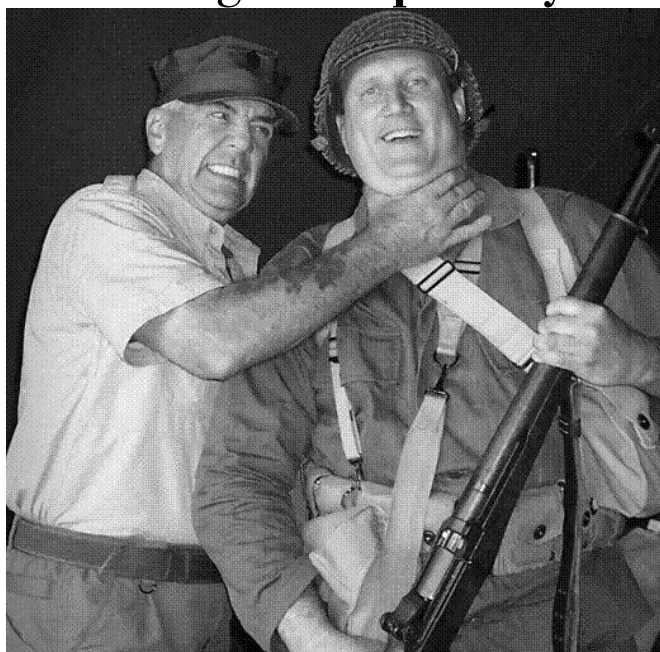
